All renewals will be due in January. Renewals not received by the end of the month will be classed as void & all contact details will be deleted.

Evie Club exclusive afternoons:

These are planned to take place in May and October during the Cambridgeshire Schools half term holidays, on the Wednesday afternoon.

All activities are subject to volunteer numbers, engine serviceability, weather and other factors out of our control.

All Evie club members must be accompanied by their parent/guardian at all times. They will be closely supervised by our volunteers, for example when driving, but you must be on the train with them.

You are welcome to bring siblings under 3 but everyone aged 3+ will be expected to have their own membership. Young siblings are welcome to ride the trains and play with the garden games for example but other activities such as craft will not be suitable due to small parts.

Sometimes members will be invited to access areas of the railway, with our volunteers, not normally open to visitors. These areas are inherently more hazardous and unlikely to be suitable for lively toddlers. Please bring an additional adult if possible if you have a young child.
